

Northeastern University

Founded in 1923, Northeastern University (NEU) is under the direct administration of the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China. It is situated in Shenyang, the central city of Northeastern China and the capital of Liaoning Province. NEU is designated as the national key university of the '211 Project' and '985 Project'. In 2017, NEU was among the "Double First Class University plan".

With more than 45,000 students currently enrolled, NEU provides 68 undergraduate degree programs, 179 postgraduate degree programs and 109 doctoral degree programs. The university has established cooperative relationship with 219 universities in 36 countries around the world.

NEU has an outstanding advantage in terms of technological innovation and application of research findings. NEU has bred a series of high-tech enterprises such as Neusoft, NEUNN and so on, among which Neusoft was the first software company that went public. With nearly 20,000 employees and subsidiaries in USA, Europe, Japan, the Middle East, and South America, Neusoft mainly provides IT solutions and services worldwide and has established marketing and service network in over 60 cities.

Authorized by the Ministry of Education, NEU offers Chinese Government Scholarship. There are currently more than 1,500 international students from 98 countries studying in NEU. Northeastern University at Qinhuangdao

Shenyang City is the capital city of Liaoning Province. With the United States, Russia, North Korea, Japan, South Korea, France, the German Consulate General and the British visa center, Shenyang is the center of politics, economy, culture, transportation, and tourism in Northeast China. The population of the city is around 8 million. The city has World Heritages such as Shenyang Imperial Palace, Fuling Tomb, Zhao Mausoleum, and so on.

The transportation in Shenyang is very convenient with extensive subway coverage, Taoxian International Airport and three train stations extending in all directions. It takes 4 hours from Shenyang to Beijing by high-speed railways.

Shenyang has four distinct seasons and beautiful environment. The temperature of the city is generally between -11 °C and 25 °C. City life is rich and wonderful with large shopping malls, recreational places, and everything you need. It is selected as the most livable city by the United Nations.

Northeastern University is located in business district with convenient transportation and is famous for its beautiful campus between Hun River and Nanhu Park. There are all kinds of sports venues such as football field, gymnasium, martial arts room, swimming pool and so on.

Northeastern University Qinhuangdao campus is part of Northeastern University. Located in the beautiful coastal city Qinhuangdao, north of Mount Yan and south of the Bohai Sea, Qinhuangdao campus has a beautiful environment and strong cultural atmosphere.

Accommodation expenses:

Single Room: 40 RMB/day;

Double room: 30 RMB/person/day (facilities including bathroom, telephone, TV, network, refrigerator, kitchen, water heater and air condition).

Monthly living expenses:

800-3000 RMB depends on students' level of consumption.

Application Schedule

Autumn semester is from September to December 30, spring semester is from March to June 30. All bachelor, master and PhD degree study starts in autumn semester and application opens between March to June. Chinese language study starts in both autumn and spring semester. Application opens all the year round.

Undergraduate, Graduate and PhD study requirement:

- 1.Non-Chinese nationality, good health condition.
- 2.Applicants for undergraduate programs, high school diploma and age under 25; Applicants for graduate programs, bachelor's degree and age under 35, two recommendation letters
Applicants for PhD programs, a master's degree, age under 40, two recommendation letters, NEU PhD supervisor's acceptance letter.
3. If you want to study program taught in Chinese, HSK5 or 6 more than 180 credit required.

Chinese Education:

1. Chinese language training

Chinese language study starts in March and September every year and takes half a year (or more). Based on the applications of the students and the results of their Chinese proficiency interview, we will assign applicants to different level of Chinese classes. Courses are offered from Monday to Friday, totally about 20-24 hours per week. Cultural elective courses such as Tai Chi, Calligraphy and Guqin are opened for registration. We also offer free HSK guidance class.

Tuition fee: 7,500 RMB/half year, 14,000 RMB/year. Registration fee for each new student: 500 RMB.

2. Bachelor of Chinese Language

Students gaining required amount of credits in 4 years, and pass HSK 6 will be granted undergraduate diploma. After they successfully defending their thesis shall be conferred the Bachelor of Arts. Students who have passed HSK 5 or above), and have passed the university's review, could complete the degree in 3 years.

Besides required courses, we offer elective courses such as Chinese Martial Arts, Chinese Music Listening, Chinese Calligraphy, Chinese Film and Television, Chinese Ancient Works Reading etc. On the basis of Chinese teaching, we would like to improve students' understanding on Chinese culture and aesthetics.

Tuition fee: 16,000 RMB/ year. Registration fee for each new student: 500 RMB.
